1591	Oct 11	And also the said Alice hath a childe and never gave thanks according to the Lawe
1558	Mar 21	<i>H W Evide*otestim sequent facta xxj Marcij Anno Dom 1558 sup val. Testamenti Willem Hurde nup de Riall def</i> Evidence regarding the will of William Hurde (at the right above the entry et exam. Sup dict testam lib. Cond. Test prod inr & in the date column Testus primus and Holden) <u>William Boylow</u> of Besthorp par R [Registry] dioc P. who has lived at Ryall for 14 years states: " The Saide Testament exhibited and remaining in the Registry being redd to the deponent ys trew in every part thereof for the tuysdaie [Tuesday] before xij th day last past this deponent was in the chamber where the said Testator laie there in his death bedd and he harde the saide Testator in effect reverse all the contents of the saide will beinge then as this deponent saithe of perfect minde and memorie and desned one M ^r <u>Holdesh</u> vicker [Vicar] of Riall to write the same will which he wrote forthwith in the presence of John Abridge, James Inman and John Waterfall" <u>Jacobus Inman</u> of Besthorpp, a parishioner of Riall for 14 years states: "That the same testament is the last will and testament of the said William Hurde deceased and that hit ys trew in every part thereof for he harde the same William Hurde now deceased promise by mouthe all the effects of the saide William the same daie he died which was the Tuesdaie before xijth day last part being as this deponent saith then of perfect mynde and memorie being present there this deponent "in company with John Brigge and John Waterfall with others. <u>John Waterfall</u> of Belsthorp parishioner of Riall from his birth & about xxij years old supports the statement of the first witness. 1588	July 15	S Elizabeth ffreston for not cominge to the churche (and on Dec 10) Thomas Osburne & his wife for committing fornicattion before they were maryed
1588	Dec 10	Silvester Patchett for abusing Mrs Swanne in wordes.
1588/9	Jan 28	(given 1588, in modern calendar would be 1589) ? <i>Netham</i> Anthony Mack stated that Agnes <u>Repthain</u> dies intestate & also that Thomas Tampion & Walter ffletcher (a natural son of Emma Tampion, the natural daughter of Agnes) may be appointed administrator.
1589	Sept 23	S The churchwardens have not presented an incest betwixt brother and sister: not presentinge the fowre copell beinge maryed at Stowe, viz; Henry *, Thomas Osburne, ffrancis Grener, & John Norton: also ther panes of glasse are in decaye of the churche: for sufferinge children to disturb the minister: and not presentinge thos [those] which be absent: not taking the forfeiture: also Henry Natlande and John Norton common drunkards: divers of the taverns on the saboethe [Sabbath], and some that sell bread and ale in the tyme of service

1589	Sept 2	The Vicar weareth not the surples, nether doeth he saye service accordinge to the booke of common prayer: Eliz ffreston for not coming to the church
1589	Sept 17	The Vicar to certify that he doethe the service accordinge to the booke of Common Prayer.
1580	Apr 5	C James Nayler hath lived incontinently with one Mary Pell
1580	Feb 28	John ffracye hath gotten maid with child which is at Riall
1611	Feb 21	S Thomas Noble charged with undue intimacy with Katharine ye housekeeper of ye said Noble. John Coxen & Maria his wife for fornication before marriage
1611	Mar 6	John Coxen answers that they were contracted in matrimony & that he is now married to her
1612	Apr 3	S Christopher Browne for reading of prayers in Essendine Church not being licensed and being discharged
1584	Mar 19	S Elizabeth ffreston absenting herself from church on holy days & Sabothe dayes: and (Jan 26) hath not been at the church this 12 monethes; & 27 Oct
1586	May 3	S John (above? James) Chremes [?], T Batson, absent from church this 12 months. Elizabeth ffreston & June 2 & Feb 11
1586	June 2	Hugo Woodd & John Chremes [?] did not communicate since this xij month. (See Stretton)
1558	Mar	HW/John Holden als [alias] Whitehede V [Vicar] of R [Ryhall] sites Ricus Clerke, <i>causa testam</i>
1581	May	C Eliz [Elizabeth] ffreston du not frequent her parish church as she ought to doo
1581/2	Jan 9	Eliz [Elizabeth] ffreston will not come to the parish church. Robt Askewe did not come to the church, <i>item</i> he did not receive the Communion this xij month
1583	April 8	C Eliz [Elizabeth] ffreston for not comm. [Communicating]: nor coming to church. Wright a drunkard. Norton a drunkard
1579	Oct 21	C Eliz [Elizabeth] ffreston hath not received the H.C. [Holy Communion] this iij yeres
1577	Oct 22	C John Gl*e did lye with Emma Willinson as he saith himself
1578	May 6	C Th- Jone Fowler is with child by one Marten Smyth as the fame goeth but where Smyth is they know not
1681	Oct 1	S Wardens to make a levye & assure £4 due to ffrancis Philpott late towne clerke & pay the same to him or his order att or before the tenth day of November next & certifie performance thereof next Court afterwards. Tho ^s [Thomas] Pinfeld.
1587	May 6	S Eliz [Elizabeth] ffreston for not comynge to the church, neithr receyvinge the Comm: [Communion] & 13 Jun. M ^r Swan he suffereth his hogges to be kept in the churchyard

1587	June 13	John Norton & his wife: they were maryed without license. John Greenshawe for not attending catechizing at Easter last: & 15 Nov
1588	July 15	S Eliz [Elizabeth] ffreston for not coming to church this three or five months. John Greenshawe for comm. [communicating] at Easter last, he is excomm: [excommunicated] Thos Osborne & Joane his wife comm: [committing] forn: [fornication] together before matrymonie as the fame goeth: both are presented
1588/9	Feb 11	Eliz [Elizabeth] ffreston negligent in coming to church
1606	May 2	Nicholas Bampton to certify penance
1606	July 15	Nicholas Bampton's father Gabriel B under date 12 July 1606 asked that his son Nicolas should be excused so far for not having performed his penance and desired more time
1606	Oct 2	Grace Pearson & Thos Nelson who liveth at Ketton: incon: [incontinent]
1589	Oct 2	S* g ^o [?] Hen ^y [Henry] Notham of R [Ryhall] that he hath married being precontracted
158#	Oct 2	Eliz [Elizabeth] Freston (ut sup*). 1 Mar excomm [excommunicated]
1617	ND	Daniel Maune als [alias] Meade cl. [cleric] V. [Vicar] perp. [perpetual?] of R. Ryhall rec. [received?] gen. [general?] lic Licence to preach.
1629	Dec 11	Anthonius ffaulkner cl. [cleric] AM [Artium Magister means Master of Arts and means that he has a degree] lic [licensed] as Coadjutor of Daniel Meade als [alias] Maune the V. [Vicar] of R. [Ryhall]
1635	June 25	Par. clk. [Parish clerk] Not allowed of by the bp [bishop]
1635	Feb 18	John Hayes & Margt [Margaret] Taylor comm. forni [committed fornication] as is commonly repted. [reputed]
1636	Aug 31	Sarah wife of Tho ^s Hearson fame of adult [adultery] with Jo Brightman of Greatford
1638	May 10	Thos Lifford & Alice Aimson: fornic. [fornication] Ana Ousburne: * excomm: [excommunicated]
1638	Oct 10	M ^r Balboynton (C [Curate] of Bestrop) for keeping company with an excomm: [excommunicated] person. M ^r B states he hath sometimes been in his company & that he hath gone to him to confer with him to reform him & that he hath at other times been in his company. Tho ^s Lilford for standing excom [excommunicated]. W ^m Holmes for not paying ch duties being 6 ^s 3 ^d . Tho ^s Barbour silr [?] 6 ^s 8 ^d . Tho ^s Waterfall silr [?] 20 ^s . W ^m Palmer & Ana Waterfall of Bestrop incont bef marr [incontinent before marriage]
1612	June 13	Rich Swan V [Vicar] for not readinge his divine service accordinge to the booke of common praier

- 1613 Oct 15 Tho^s Hearson for being marryed but lawfully or not we know not - He is married lawfully by a lycense from M^r D^r Hyll. Wardens (John Waterfall, John Weight) for not having wyne sufficient at the Comm [Communion] at Easter
- 1613 Oct 29 Thos Hearson & wife state they are marryed by virtue of a lycense from the authoritye of the L bishop of Lincoln
- 1612 Oct 31 Thos Noble being a maryed man & havinge a wife for kepeinge companie with Katharine Waffeld being beforetimes presented for livinge incontinently & he being called & admonished by the Chancellerie of this Court not to come into her companie yet hath in keeping he companie privately & openly disobeyed the sd order & lyveth with her as before
- 1598 Nov 18 S Helena a common scold to cert reg pen [certify ?] 29 Nov: John Waterfall for working on the Sabothe daye. J W admits that he wrought upon St Matthew's daye: to cert [certify] 29 Nov reg pen [?]
- 1598 Nov 29 John Waterfall Warden, presents that James Inman of Belmesthorpe in the parish of Ryall did play at cards in time of Divine Service on Sondaye at Evening Prayer being the Sondaie before Michaelmas last paste. Also George Baron for shearinge yews on sondaie aboute Bartholomew (St Bartholomew's Day - August 24th) which is not cited
- 1605 Jan 18 S ... Bodending cum. Rect. [Rector] proprietary of Ryall
- 1599 Oct 23 John Waterfall: carting on the Sabothe day after Evening Prayer also for keeping a maide & they are suspected of fornication also the maid.
- 1599 Dec 10 S See Braunston
- 1631 Oct 17 W W^m [William] North & Annecalla Wallis: cursa diff: John Willet & Francis Wilson, Wardens present John Browne of Casterton pra [?]
- 1631 Mar 1 Exec [Executors] of Dan Meade late V [Vicar] to pay mostuaries [?]
- 1626 Jan 18 M John Heason for lyveing incontinently with Sara Heason as by comm: [common] fame is rep: [reported]
- 1621 May 7 M Granam Wright. There is a common fame within our parish that Granam Wright a midwife sent for a young woman a man's wife to come to a woman's labour (there being no such matter) which woman cominge to the said Granam Wright she the sd Granam enteyced her to the Alehouse where there were manie men & women drinkeinge together. And that the said Granam was so distempered with drink that she then & there did put the candle oute & pissed on to the floor - Granham Wright confesses that she beleveth she did somewhat unadvisedly send for a young woman to come to a woman's labour there being no such matter & beleveth that she was at the alehouse drinking & making merry with some men & women that then were there. But that she was so distempered with drink that she put oute the candle & pissed on the floor she utterly denyeth. But Wright produces Maria Shipley, Ammenilla Wallace, Margeria Howes, Johanna Shipley, Johanna Cubley & May Bagley, all of Ryall as a 6 manu compurgation [?]

1576	May 4	<i>C</i> <i>Eliz</i> [Elizabeth] Netham, wid, hath not <i>recd</i> [received] communion these two years
1576	May 7	<i>C</i> <i>W^m</i> [William] Richardson & <i>Eliz</i> [Elizabeth] Goodman: <i>carn cop</i> [?]
1566	ND	<i>HW</i> <i>Joh John/Jonathan</i> Whythed <i>cl</i> [cleric] <i>V.</i> [Vicar] of <i>R.</i> [Ryhall] <i>aetat</i> [?] 60 has been there about xxj years states he has licence to marry within the fourth degree of affinity - offers himself for <i>exam</i> [examination]
1592	Nov 21	<i>S</i> <i>Eliz</i> [Elizabeth] Freestone for a recusant
1616	Oct 30	<i>S</i> <i>Tho^s</i> [Thomas] Noble & Mary Shipley for standing <i>excomm:</i> [excommunicated]: <i>Essendine Rich</i> [Richard] Swan <i>V.</i> [Vicar] of <i>R.</i> [Ryhall] for not readinge nor procuringe to be <i>redd dyvne</i> service on the <i>sab</i> [Sabbath] <i>daye</i> on the Sunday last was fortnight nor on St Mathew's day last
1634	June 25	<i>W</i> John Bose of Whittering <i>g^a</i> [?] <i>W^m</i> [William] Wills of Belmesthorpe. <i>Caus. subt. Legati</i>
1450	circ	<i>Early Chanc Doc B 7 N^o202</i> <i>Robt</i> [Robert] & <i>Tho^s</i> [Thomas] Torold <i>Tho^s</i> [Thomas] Laxeden <i>execs</i> [executors] of Jane sometime the wife of the <i>sd</i> [said] <i>Robt</i> [Robert] <i>vers</i> [versus] John Brown of Stamf [Stamford] & Alex Mercer feoff of the <i>sd</i> [said] Jane regarding lands <i>pc</i> [?] in <i>Stamf</i> [Stamford] Ryall & Belmesthorpe
